

Title: How to find MB2 canal in maxillary molars?

Abstract

Maxillary molars may present a challenge to clinicians due to the complex anatomy that can lead to failure in locating the second mesiobuccal (MB2) canal. Not locating this canal can decrease the likelihood of long-term success. The key to finding MB2 canals lies in clinician's ability to read and understand the internal anatomy and the map that the floor of each tooth offers. Other factors that may influence the clinical location of MB2 canals are the clinical experiences of dentists, use of special instruments and magnifying equipment.

This lecture clarifies the steps on how to find and manage MB2 canal in maxillary molars.
