
Title : Cervical fillings are gone too soon?

Abstract



Cervical restoration with composite resin is one of most common treatment that is performed in dental clinics. The procedure for the class 5 composite resin restorations looks easy: etch, bonding, placing resin, and finishing & polishing in case of total etch bonding system. Despite of this very easy-looking procedure, the dentists seems to have concerns for dislodgement of cervical restorations within a very short time. In this lecture, the reasons of dislodgement and the ways to avoid the dislodgement within the short time will be discussed. The details of restorations procedures will be presented as well. The audience may find the clinical know-hows for class 5 composite resin restorations from this lecture.
