Title: Predictable and successful delivery of zirconia restoration

Abstract



Patients demand esthetics. The incorporation of zirconia in clinical dentistry offers a new alternative to metal-free esthetic dentistry. There has been a monumental shift in the use of zirconia in esthetic/restorative dentistry. Zirconia-based restorative materials exhibit improved strength, versatility of clinical indications, and the ability to be CAD/CAM milled. They are also an alternative to the increasingly higher cost of precious metals.

This lecture aims to present and discuss the successful clinical application of zirconia-based restoration in dentistry in regard of surface treatment, priming, cementation and bonding. Potential to significantly simplify and expedite adhesive protocols will be thoroughly discussed.
